The Town of Wilton will hold a public meeting on the U.S. EPA Brownfields-funded Cleanup Project at the former Forster Mill site located on Depot Street in Wilton, Maine. The public meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 18, 2017 at 6:30 PM at the Wilton Town Office (158 Weld Road, Wilton, ME 04294). A Remediation Feasibility Analysis (RFA)/Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) have been prepared. During this public meeting, representatives from the Town, U.S. EPA, Maine DEP, and/or Ransom Consulting, Inc. will discuss the results of the RFA/ABCA and the recommended cleanup strategies for the site. In addition, representatives will also discuss Section 106 of the National Historical Preservation Act, with respect to the proposed cleanup actions.

The Town is receiving public comments on these documents, and the public comment period will run 30 days, ending on Thursday, August 17, 2017. The information repository on this project, including the RFA/ABCA, prior environmental assessments, and other environmental information is located at the Wilton Town Office and is available for viewing 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM on Monday and Tuesday, and 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Thursday and Friday.
