Request for Bids

Hauling Municipal Solid Waste and Bulky Waste Materials from Town Transfer Station

The Town of Wilton is accepting sealed proposals for solid waste/bulky waste transportation services to be hauled in Town-owned 40 and 50 cubic yard roll off containers from the Transfer Station located at 211 Munson Road, Wilton Maine to Waste Management Disposal Services of Maine, Inc., Crossroads Landfill, 357 Mercer Road, Norridgewock, Maine. After transportation of roll-off containers filled with solid waste, demolition debris or bulky waste materials to the disposal site, the contractor shall transport the empty roll-off container back to the Wilton Transfer Station or provide a 50 cubic yard container on a swap basis with the town's containers, allowing for the option of a single haul to the Wilton site. Travel distance is approximately 30 miles one way. The contractor shall transport roll-off containers on an appropriate over-the-road tractor with an appropriate chassis or trailer with hydraulic boom and winch. Proposals shall be submitted as a price per haul. Approximately 80 hauls or 930 tons annually are anticipated for solid waste and approximately 55 hauls or 450 tons for bulky waste demolition debris. In addition, additional hauls may be required for other bulky waste or demolition items. The Town shall call Contractor for pick-up and hauling as needed.

The Contractor is invited to bid on the terms (See attached form).

The Contractor shall obtain and maintain at no expense to the Town the following insurance coverage:

1. A Commercial General Liability Insurance Policy shall afford limits no less than the following:
 - \$2,000,000 - General Aggregate
 - \$1,000,000 - Products & Completed Operations Aggregate
 - \$1,000,000 - Personal & Advertising Injury
 - \$1,000,000 - Each Occurrence
 - \$ 50,000 - Fire Damage
 - \$ 5,000 - Medical Expense
2. Automobile Liability Insurance covering owned, non-owned and hired vehicles. Said policy of insurance to have a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury (including death) and property damage (with Pollution Exclusion removed).

3. Worker's Compensation Insurance and Employer's liability insurance policy with a statutory limit of workers compensation of a limit of \$1,000,000 per accident for employer's liability.

Prior to commencement of services, the Contractor shall deliver to the Town certificates satisfactory to the Town evidencing such insurance coverage is in effect.

Permits and Licenses necessary for hauling and disposal of solid waste shall be secured and paid by the Contractor.

A Report of company motor vehicle violations for the company's hauling operation for the last three years in the State of Maine.

Term of Agreement will be based upon the terms as selected by the Town. The contract term is to begin when the bid is accepted. The contract shall be for a two-year term.

All proposals are to be submitted in a sealed envelope marked **“TRANSFER STATION HAULING BID”** to the Town of Wilton at the Town Office, 158 Weld Road, Wilton, ME 04294 **by 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 13, 2026, to be opened at that time, and considered at the next selectboard's meeting on January 20, 2026 at 6:00 pm.**
