Job Summary

This is manual labor in the operation of light to moderately and motorized equipment for on road construction and repair; motorized and manual equipment for grounds maintenance and operations of the Public Works Department and Parks and Recreation Department. Employees of this class can handle and operate all truck attachments and carry out assignments with relative ease. Employees participate in loading and unloading work. Duties include the performance of manual labor tasks in connections with the operation of trucks or other functions of the Public Works Department. Work instructions may be received in detail for each job to be performed or may follow an established routine. Work is subject to review while in progress and upon completion by the Public Works Foreman. The Utility employee will be responsible for maintenance of the town's cemeteries, parks and grounds as directed by the Public Works Foreman

Responsibilities

- May operate other light equipment as needed on an incidental or emergency basis.
- Operates a light or moderately truck transporting dirt, gravel, wood and construction materials; assists in loading or unloading trucks.
- Shall be responsible and shall perform varied work in the seasonal repair and maintenance of Town Parks, Cemeteries, and Grounds.
- Performs varied work at the Transfer Station/Recycling Center.
- Performs varied work in general related activities of the Public Works Department, including brush removal, equipment maintenance and general clean-up.
- Assists in general repair and preventive maintenance on vehicles and equipment and assists in general maintenance of the Public Works garage.
- Performs related work as may be required.
- Responsible to the Public Works Foreman.



Job Requirements

- Thorough knowledge of the standard practices, methods, equipment and tools of the automotive, construction equipment trade, and grounds keeping trade.
- Knowledge of the traffic laws, ordinances and rules involved in the operation of automotive vehicles.
- Working knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions of the trade.
- Ability to perform manual labor of extended periods of time under adverse climatic conditions.
- Physical strength and agility sufficient to perform the work of this class.
- Ability to carry out general instructions independently and follow more detailed instructions with some guidance.
