Most, if not all the other pavement plants add old pavement into their mix to reduce the amount of new liquid asphalt they need to add to the pavement. We believe the virgin mix creates a longer lasting and more flexible pavement, providing additional years of service life to your roads. Since the pavement plant owner is the brother to our owner we receive priority at the plant to keep our production rate, while not having our trucks waiting at the plant to get loaded.

The company has been privately owned by the same person since it was established in 2009. The owner of the company is on site during paving operations ensuring all work is done properly, safely, and efficiently.

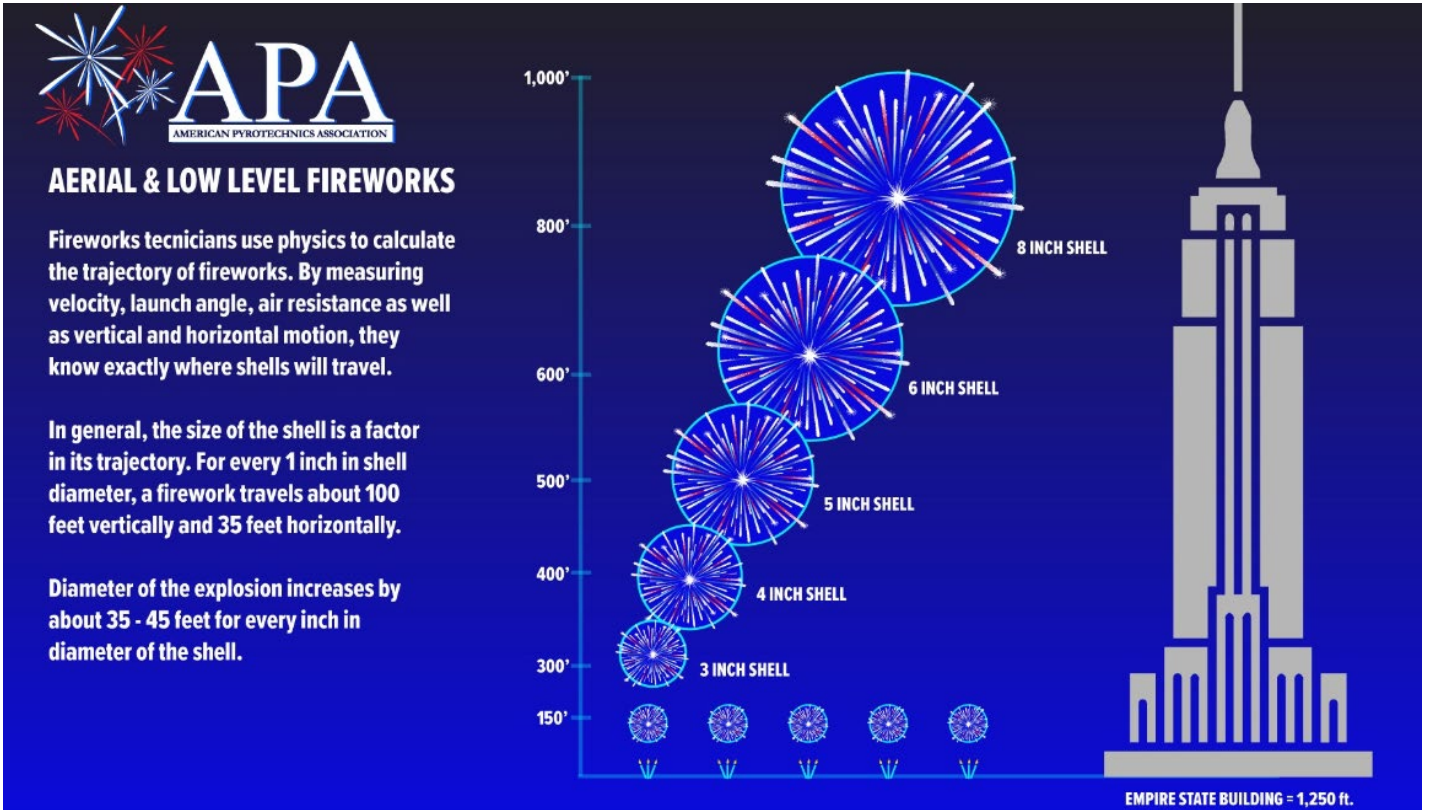
